The Covington County Business Development Center is owned and operated by the Covington County Economic Development Commission. The business incubator is a business that provides advice, equipment, temporary premises, or other facilities to those starting up a business and lacking in capital.

Unlike many business assistance programs, business incubators do not serve any and all companies. Entrepreneurs who wish to enter a business incubation program must apply for admission. Acceptance criteria vary from program to program, but in general only those with feasible business ideas and a workable business plan are admitted.

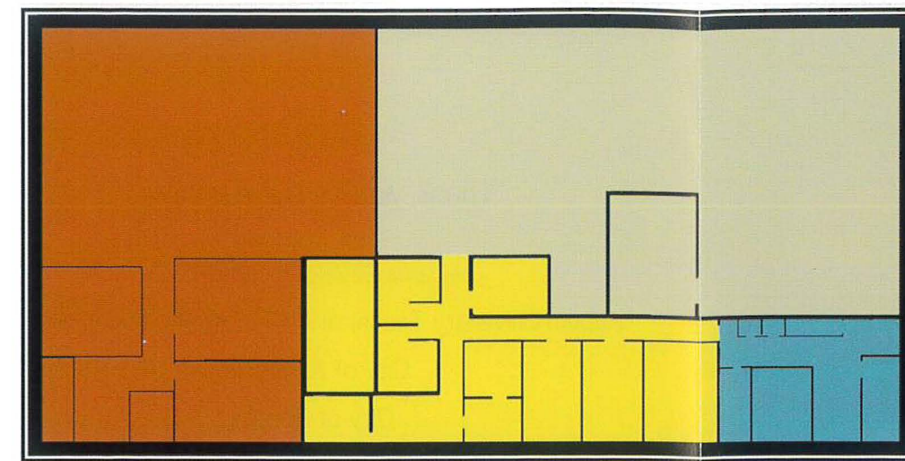

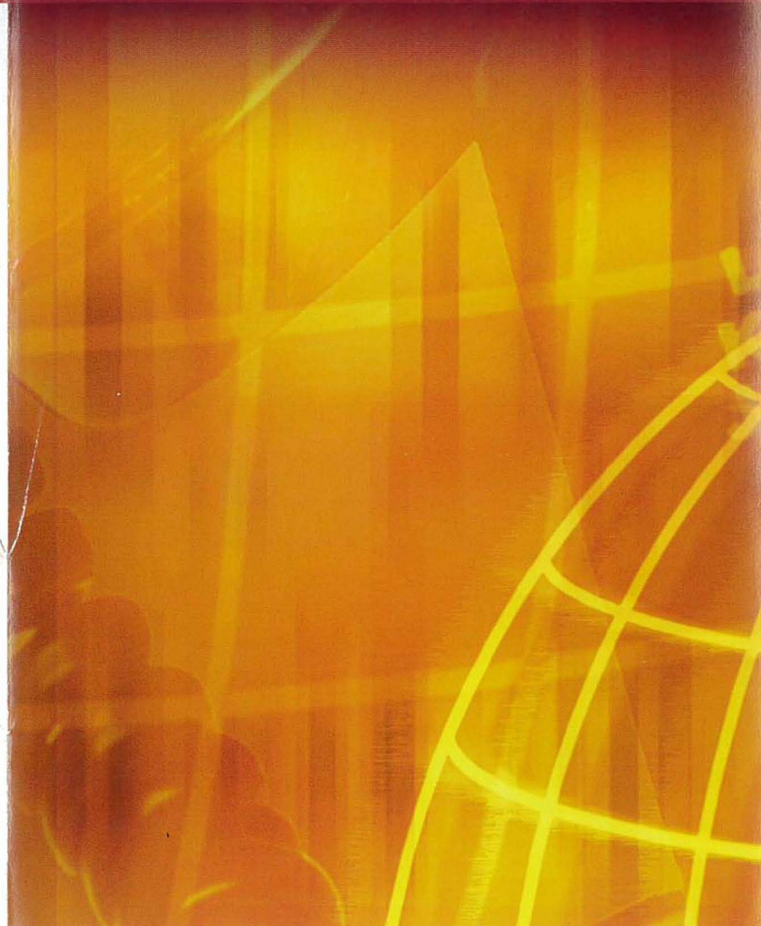
- The Business Development Center consist of two manufacturing bays both expandable to 9,000 square feet.
